The Syllabus

▶ The Language and Literature exam is divided in 2 parts:

- > Poetry and Prose (2 essays in one hour thirty minutes)
 - One essay in Poetry on a given poem studied in class [45 min]
 - One essay on a literary text, novel or short story also studied in class [45 min]
- > Shakespeare and Modern Drama (2 essays in one hour thirty minutes)



- One essay on Shakespeare [45 min]
- One essay on modern drama [45 min]
